## REQUEST for Review and Modification of Child Support Order

While you are incarcerated, the child support order in your case continues to charge, whether you have the ability to pay or not. However, you may be able to get your support order reduced or suspended while you are incarcerated. After evaluating the length and reason for your incarceration, the Child Support Agency (CSA) will determine whether it is appropriate to assist you with a modification. If you are incarcerated for any of the following crimes, the CSA will not assist you with a modification.

- Non-payment of child support on any case
- Committing a crime against any child
- Committing a crime against the party receiving child support

If you want to request a modification of your child support order, please complete this form and return it to *Green Lake County*. The county child support agency will notify you of its decision after reviewing your request. If your case meets the requirements for a review and modification, instructions will be mailed to you. Please complete a separate form for each county in which you have a case.

You may also have a private attorney ask the court to modify your order, or you may contact the Clerk of Court in the county responsible for enforcing your order.
