#### Bike Route Sign Placement Agreement

This Agreement is between Green Lake County ("County"), a quasi-municipal corporation with its seat of government, and principal place of business located at 571 County Road A, Green Lake, WI 54941, and Green Lake Greenways, Inc., a registered non-profit organization in the State of Wisconsin.

Now, in consideration of the promises and covenants herein contained and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

#### 1. Purpose and Scope.

- a. Purpose. This Agreement is for the placement of bike route signs on County highways. The Parties recognize that bike route signage is a valuable asset to the County and improves bike safety.
- b. Scope. The county highways where bike route signs will be installed will be mutually agreed upon by the parties.
- c. If Green Lake Greenways Inc., requests additional bike route signs installed, any additional Bike Route Signs must be approved by the Green Lake County Highway Committee and must be considered desirable as shown on the *Green Lake County Wisconsin Bicycle* map as provided by Wisconsin Department of Transportation at http://wisconsindot.gov/Pages/travel/bike/bike-maps/county.aspx.

#### 2. Definitions

"Bike route" means any highway which has been duly designated by the Green Lake County Highway Committee in conjunction with Green Lake Greenways, Inc., and which is identified by appropriate signs and markings.

"Install" means to construct, manufacture, fabricate, build, raise, assemble, place, affix, attach, create, paint, draw, or in any other way bring into being or establish a sign or sign structure, but it does not include any of the foregoing activities when performed as customary maintenance of the sign or sign structure.

"Maintain" or "maintenance" means to keep in a state of repair, efficiency, or validity; to preserve from failure or decline; and to allow to exist.

#### 3. Signs

a. The sole authority for sign size, design, installation, maintenance, and placement belongs to the County by and through the Green Lake County Highway Department, after consultation with Green Lake Greenways. Installation, placement and maintenance shall be consistent with the Wisconsin MUTCD or other applicable state laws, administrative codes or other industry accepted standards.

#### b. Installation/Maintenance

- i. Signs will be installed and maintained by Green Lake Highway Department personnel under the direction of the Green Lake County Highway Commissioner and recorded in a sign database. All sign supplies will be stored in a location designated by the Green Lake County Highway Commissioner or designee.
- ii. Signs may be installed on approved existing sign posts when feasible, consistent with the Wisconsin MUTCD or other applicable state laws, administrative codes or other industry accepted standards. If an existing sign post cannot accommodate a Bike Route sign, the Green Lake County Highway Commissioner shall have the sole authority to determine where the Bike Route sign post shall be installed, after consultation with Green Lake Greenways.
- iii. This agreement is solely for the installation of Bike Route signs on County Trunk Highways. Any bike route signs required on Town, City or Village roads require approval from each respective municipality. The County will not install bike route signs on Town, City or Village roads.
- iv. The County reserves the right to remove Bike Route signs if they present a danger to the motoring public. If the County determines that a sign must be removed, it will inform Green Lake Greenways, Inc. at least 10 business days before removal, unless an emergency situation renders advance notice infeasible.

#### c. Cost

- i. Green Lake Greenways will be responsible for the cost of all Bike Route signs and posts. The County will mail an invoice for the cost of the signs and posts to the address in paragraph 5.c. below. Payment is due 30 days after the receipt of the invoice. Late payments will incur a 1.5% interest charge on invoices unpaid after 40 days.
- ii. The County will be responsible for all sign installation costs which includes labor and incidental supplies.

- iii. If a sign or sign post is damaged due to accident, the County will attempt to recoup the cost of repair/replacement from the individual who caused the damage. If the County is unable to recoup the costs, the cost of repair /replacement shall be allocated as follows:
  - 1. If the damaged Bike Route sign is affixed to a post with a county sign, the County will be responsible for paying for the post repair/installation. Green Lake Greenways, Inc. will be responsible for the cost of the Bike Route sign.
  - 2. If the damaged Bike Route sign and post is not affixed to a post with a county sign, Green Lake Greenways, Inc. will be responsible for paying for the Bike Route sign and post. The County will be responsible for the installation costs.
  - iv. Green Lake Greenways is responsible for Bike Route sign maintenance costs consisting of replacement signs and posts. The County will provide an invoice for the cost maintenance, payment of which is due 30 days after the receipt of the invoice. Late payments will incur a 1.5% interest charge on invoices unpaid after 40 days.

#### 4. Liability for Accident and Injury

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, the County expressly retains its protections under Wis. Stat. §895.525, 895.529 and 893.80, and any other liability limiting statute.

#### 5. Miscellaneous

- a. This Agreement shall be construed according to the laws of the State of Wisconsin and venue shall lie in the Green Lake County Circuit Court.
- b. This Agreement shall remain in force until superseded or suspended at a later date. Either party may terminate this Agreement with 30 days' written notice to the other party.
- c. Notices. All notices regarding this Agreement shall be delivered by United States mail first-class postage prepaid and will be deemed delivered three (3) days after mailing. Notices may also be delivered by commercial carrier. Notices shall be delivered to the following addresses:

d. The captions in this Agreement are for reference only and shall not be used to construe the Agreement.

- e. Each party has participated in negotiating and drafting this Agreement, so if an ambiguity or a question of intent or interpretation arises, this Agreement is to be construed as if the Parties had drafted it jointly, as opposed to being construed against a Party because it was responsible for drafting one or more provisions of this Agreement.
- f. If any term of this Agreement is to any extent illegal, otherwise invalid, or incapable of being enforced, such term shall be excluded to the extent of such invalidity or unenforceability; all other terms hereof shall remain in full force and effect; and, to the extent permitted and possible, the invalid or unenforceable term shall be deemed replaced by a term that is valid and enforceable and that comes closest to expressing the intention of such invalid or unenforceable term.
- g. The parties acknowledge that they will not hold themselves out as an agent, partner or co-venturer of the other party and that this Agreement is not intended and does not create an agency, partnership, joint venture or any other type of relationship, except the contract relationship established herein.
- h. No amendment to this Agreement shall be valid and effective unless made in writing and signed by an authorized representative of each of the parties.
- i. This Agreement may not be assigned without the express written permission of the other party, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld.
- j. This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed to be an original, but all of which, taken together, shall constitute of one and the same document.

#### 6. Effective Date

This Agreement will become effective once all parties have completed any required approval process and the appropriate representative of each party has signed below. Each individual signing this Agreement attests that they have the authority to bind their respective party to this Agreement.

In order to determine the feasibility of hiring a General Laborer, the following was evaluated, which adheres to the procedure as outlined in the Administrative Policy Manual, dated November 2012.

#### • Job Description.

The attached position description has been reviewed. The position responsibilities and duties have not changed since being updated in 2014.

#### • Job Designation.

The education, responsibilities and duties have remained the same; therefore there is no need to change classification. The Pay Group for the General Laborer position is #12, the pay range is \$19.00 and goes up to \$24.27. Starting pay range will be \$19.00 - \$20.05. #### SUMMARY:

Under general direction, maintain State and County Trunk Highways, ditches and right of way so as to aid in the safe flow of traffic throughout Green Lake County; to perform reconstruction work as needed.

#### **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

The percent of time spent on various jobs in the General Laborer classification can vary from job to job and season to season and within the season based on many variables that need to be taken into consideration. Given these elements of change, approximately:

- Snow and ice removal work, including putting up and taking down snow fence 20% of the time.
- Mowing, tree and brush control 15% of the time.
- Blacktop and shoulder work, including filling potholes 18% of the time.
- Flags and directs traffic when work is being conducted on roads 8% of the time.
- Rubber crack sealing 10% of the time.
- Patrol State and County Trunk Highways, clears debris and picks up litter 7% of the time.
- Drainage maintenance, including setting or assisting of setting culverts; cleaning culverts; may haul gravel or fill 5% of the time.
- Performs repairs on bridges, assists with annual inspections and other bridge work, as necessary 2% of the time.
- Operate heavy equipment 5% of the time.
- Assists in the upkeep, maintenance and repair of buildings, grounds and equipment.
   10% of the time.
- Performs other work as assigned by the Commissioner or Superintendent 5% of the time.

#### **SKILLS AND ABILITIES:**

- General knowledge of methods, materials and equipment used in road construction and maintenance projects.
- Ability to use a transit; determine grade and proper slope for ditches and shoulders on existing roads.
- Knowledge, ability and skill in the use of measuring devices, assorted small tools
  that could be hand or power, motorized vehicles, earth moving equipment, air
  hammers, material handling equipment, tractors, mowers, front end loaders, snow
  removal equipment, grader, dozer, paver, rollers, sand blasters, backhoe, brush
  chipper, tar kettles, mechanical brooms and other similar equipment. Assorted
  personal protective equipment as required.
- Ability and skill to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing or with hand and arm signals.
- Ability to adapt to changing conditions.
- Ability to work flexible, 40 hour/week schedule to accommodate snow removal on weekends and emergency call-ins, as necessary.
- Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with co-workers, supervisors and the public.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

**EDUCATION**: High School diploma or GED equivalency.

**EXPERIENCE / JOB KNOWLEDGE**: 1-2 years' experience working in road construction and maintenance, heavy equipment operation course, or equivalent combination of education and experience that provides the necessary knowledge, skills and abilities. Must possess and maintain a valid commercial driver's license (CDL) with A, B, C, D, and N endorsements.

#### **WORKING CONDITIONS:**

PHYSICAL DEMANDS: Given the variable and seasonal functions of this position, physical demands vary greatly from work assignments and seasonal demands. Approximately 75-90% of the time, depending on the actual work assignment, the employee will be performing work which could involve acute vision demands, walking, bending and twisting, feeling, standing, reaching, sitting, climbing hills or stairs, stooping, kneeling, verbally communicating, grappling, crouching, balancing, crawling and climbing ladders and getting on and off equipment are all required at various times and for various assignments. Good physical dexterity of arms and hands, legs and feet is necessary for accurate and safe operation of heavy equipment. Communications while working may be verbal. Good peripheral vision is necessary to assist the operator with maintenance and construction work as well as safety in work operations especially when working in traffic. Vision and hearing are important to this job as are hand and

eye coordination. Approximately 10-25% of a shift may be spent lifting and carrying up to 80 pounds, as required.

**ENVIRONMENTAL DEMANDS:** Up to 95% of work can be performed outdoors, exposed to seasonal weather elements, which could mean extreme hot, cold or humid conditions; 75% of work has exposure to noise or work involving vibration; 5% of work could be performed indoors. Hazards of this position include dangers from mechanical equipment, fast moving vehicles, heights, burns, fumes, mists or gasses, noxious odors, exposure to weather, dust, heat, equipment noise and fumes, electrical, and chemicals. May be required to work long or unusual hours as necessary to meet departmental needs.

This is a public service position, and employee is required to be courteous, cooperative and respectful at all times with the public and clients; also establishes and maintains a courteous and cooperative and respectful working relationship with other employees, supervisors and public officials.

This position description has been prepared to assist in defining job responsibilities, physical demands, working conditions and needed skills. It is not intended as a complete list of job duties, responsibilities and/or essential functions. This description is not intended to limit or modify the rights of any supervisor to assign, direct, and control the work of employees under supervision. The county retains and reserves any and all rights to change, modify, amend, add to or delete from, any section of this document as it deems, in its' judgment, to be proper.
