Brooks and Hurst met with Attorney Sorenson and a revised proposed agreement will be put together.

#### Fuel

Discussion was held. Eight vendors were submitted at inquiry on November 21, 2013 to see if they were able to meet Green Lake County specification and terms. Six vendors were not able to meet what we specified. Energy Solutions and Landmark Services Coop can meet our specifications. It was noted that Landmark was higher in 2010 when fuel was bid out; and that we have not had any problems with equipment due to improper blending of fuel in the winter with Energy Solutions. Also, on average during the last 5 years, we have saved anywhere between .17-.20 per gallon by locking in the price. *Motion/second (Whirry/Henke)* to stay with Energy Solution Partners and to work with them to lock in the price, and send inquiries out to fuel suppliers every 3 years.
