COUNTY FAIR PUBLIC OUTREACH - LAND INFORMATION

Planning & Zoning Director Matt Kirkman requested funding for a booth at the 2018 Green Lake County Fair to provide information to the public regarding land information. The booth would be manned by the P&Z department and would include an AR sandbox which provides virtual topography. The cost is \$125.00 per year.

COMMIT TO 2020 AERIAL FUNDING

Stanuch explained that the orthophotography needs to be done in 2020. The total cost is \$35,000 with \$15,000 to come from the Non-Metallic Mining grant.

Motion/second (*Guenther/Kirkman*) to apply for \$20,000 for the ortho photography through the Strategic Fund Grant application done in 2019 for 2020. All ayes. Motion carried.

LAND INFORMATION OFFICER REPORT

• Update on grant projects – PLSS: 22 corners are due in October which is 80% complete. Matt Kirkman

explained that this remonumentation project will be complete in 2023 but after that we should be on a 20 year maintenance plan.

- Treasurer Amanda Toney stated that Transcendent is updating and testing the implementation.
- Sheriff Podoll stated that the Emergency Services draft atlas looks good and should be complete this fall.
