DISCUSSION AND ACTION ON OPRGANIZATIONAL ASSESSMENT – DEB PAGEL, SCHENCK

Pagel appeared by phone to discussed the organizational assessment. The Committee asked for clarification on some points. Pagel answered questions and provided background into the report. Pagel will clarify the report based on the questions asked and then send a final report for the County Board meeting on December 15th. The structure of how a county administrator would function within the entire organization was discussed. The need for a strategic plan was discussed. Discussion held.

Pagel explained that travel expenses of additional trips caused the cost of the project to go over budget. The 25% for travel and expenses was removed from the original proposal when the project was adopted. Discussion was held.

Motion/second(*Reabe/Starshak*) to recommend approval to the County Board for Pagel's request to provide the additional funds of \$3,000 for expenses. Motion failed, 0 ayes, 5 nays.
