Chief Deputy's seven weak links in Security

Continuing discussion held on four of Chief Deputy Putzke's seven weak links in the security system:

- Door propping and piggy backing this was previously discussed at the March 27 meeting with continuing discussion today. Sheriff Podoll outlined the current non-compliance problems throughout the complex. Discussion held regarding the possibility of requiring employees to swipe their badge upon exit as well as entrance to improve accountability. Discussion also held regarding interns and the security privileges they require.
- Staff losing their badges discussion held on the current policy for employees losing their badge. There is a \$10.00 charge to the employee and a 24 hour notice to the County Clerk's office.
- Outside vendors discussion held on the various department policies regarding outside vendors such as maintenance and law enforcement. Motion made by Judge Slate to require background checks on all vendor personnel and allow each department to determine what level of security they would provide for on-site vendors. No second. This will be discussed at the next meeting with various departments providing their current policy.
- Background checks for prospective employees and interns discussion held on the current policy. Law Enforcement and HHS will provide their policies at the next meeting for further review.
