WORKSHOP - PROPOSED A-2 GENERAL AGRICULTURAL ZONING DISTRICT

<u>Shute</u> – Explained that he created a document that incorporated comments from members of the Town of Marquette town board and Kathleen Moore.

<u>Starshak</u> - This is a combination of two existing agricultural districts. This has been on every agenda since March and is the fourth workshop.

<u>Phil Anastasi, Town of Marquette Chairman</u> – Discussed the ordinance section in regard to cemeteries. Asked about a set time table for adopting the proposed amendment; the Town is looking for some sort of timeline. The Town or Marquette is in the process of organizing to discuss the proposed changes. Other questions included how many animals are allowed per acre. He suggested that, when amending the ordinance, the committee grandfather in the existing uses and restrict the new.

LAND INFORMATION UPDATES

A. LAND INFORMATION COMMITTEE/COUNCIL HISTORY BY ATTORNEY DAN HURST

<u>Shute</u> – Gave each of the committee members a packet of information that was provided by Corporation Counsel Dan Hurst regarding historical information pertaining to the Land Information Council.

<u>Starshak</u> – It's informational for the committee. It will be placed on the next agenda.

DEPARTMENT/COMMITTEE ACTIVITY

a. Agricultural Zoning Districts

<u>Shute</u> – Changes will be made as requested and will be brought forward as a public hearing item for October.

b. Continued discussion on 25-foot setbacks

<u>Shute</u> – A letter was sent to each of the towns advising them of the discussion regarding the 25' setbacks. So far, only one of the town officials has responded and he is not overly supportive of the 25' setback change without some good criteria for setting that distance. The 25' setback that triggered the discussion was a setback that the county originally didn't have to provide because it was originally part of a discussion that involved an unzoned town and the WI-DNR administrative rule didn't provide a streetyard setback.

c. Private Sewage Ordinance; amend to delete maintenance affidavit

<u>Shute</u> – There is redundancy in some of the paperwork and Code Enforcement Officer Missy Sorenson has suggested that the ordinance be amended to delete the section that requires a maintenance affidavit.

Motion by Moderow/Reabe, to amend the POWTS ordinance and bring it to public hearing in September.

d. NR115 updates, if any

<u>Shute</u> – The DNR public hearing notice was given to each committee member.

e. Use of department carryover fund for public land survey system corner project <u>Shute</u> – Last year's project cost approximately \$24,000 for surveying corners. The plan is to survey another 20 corners. I'm seeking the committee's approval to use carryover funds from 1998 to supplement the existing \$10,000 with an additional \$18,000 from carryover funds to do about 25 more corners.
