(± 10.00 Acres) **Explanation:** The owner/applicant is requesting a conditional use permit to expand a non-metallic mining operation to the southern 10 acres of the current site.

<u>Dan Egbert, Egbert Excavating, Inc., W1302 N. Lawson Drive, Green Lake</u> – Applicant explained the operation and spoke in favor of the request.

<u>James Fox – Town of Green Lake Chairman, N3195 Luedke Road</u> – Spoke on behalf of the town in favor of the request.

<u>Wayne Albright, County Road A</u> – Adjoining property owner spoke in favor of the request.

<u>Attorney Mark Slate, Representing Don Koller (adjoining property owner)</u> – On behalf of Mr. Koller, spoke against the request.

Tom Fisher, Representing James and Violet Fisher Trust, 4214 Heffernan Drive, Madison, WI, (neighbor) – Spoke against the request; explained his concerns about safety and ground water. Suggested that experts look into the neighbors' issues.

<u>Shute</u> – Read letter from Leo Wilke, an adjoining property owner, who opposes the request.

<u>Don Koller, Route 2 (adjoining property owner)</u> – Spoke against the request.

The committee also discussed the need to rezone this parcel from agricultural to mining.

Motion by Mueller/Sell, unanimously carried on roll call (4-ayes, 0-nays), to lay this request over pending the rezoning of this area from agricultural to mining. Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENT

<u>Jim Fox – Town of Green Lake Chairman</u> – When it comes to water, 30-40 years ago, anytime a well is drilled within 5 miles of this site, anyone within 3 miles away gets a cloudy, red, and contaminated well because it must be on the same stream so this isn't a new issue. I have documents that show this. When Brooks drilled those irrigation wells, for a few days the water of the neighbors within 3-4 miles lost its color and taste. This is not a new issue in that area of the Town of Green Lake.

With Mr. Koller being closer to the site, it may be more severe. Now everything is getting more technical. I think these questions should be answered.
