#### APPROVING JOB DESCRIPTION FOR THE MECHANIC/PARTS FOREMAN POSITION

Brooks presented a job description for a mechanic/parts foreman. This is proposed to combine the shop foreman position and a mechanic position. The job description and wage were reviewed and discussed. Henke stated that he is not in favor of losing a man in the highway department. Highway is short staff as it is. This will result in a loss of a position, but highway will review this in the future if needed. *Motion/second(Trochinski/Henke)* to approve the job description and proposed wage. Motion carried.

## DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON SUPPLEMENTAL PAY POLICIES

Bostelmann explain the supplemental pays. Discussion was held. Bostelmann will work with Highway and Maintenance to determine safety shoe purchases in the future. On call pay for HHS and Maintenance and shift differential for Maintenance will remain the same until the wage study is complete. Law Enforcement is working on a revision in shift differential and their uniform allowance language.

# DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY MANUAL & COUNTY PERSONNEL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES MANUAL

The committee reviewed the Policy and Manual and discussed typos and language clarification on Payroll Periods and Payment of Wages. Both documents will have consistent language. Corrections will be made and the documents will be sent out to the department heads and the Committee. The Committee will approve the documents at their regular meeting scheduled for November 15<sup>th</sup>.

## **GHT HEALTH INSURANCE PREMIUM COSTS**

Bostelmann provided the premiums for health insurance. The PPO plan will be an increase of 10%. If all employees have the HMO the increase will be 4%. Bostelmann requested approval to move forward with the HMO and have the employee contributions remain the same as the 2012 contribution.

*Motion/second(Henke/Trochinski)* to approve HMO with the same benefit coverage, deductible and employee contributions as 2012. Motion carried.
