July 11, 2019 Monthly Staff Report

June Projects

1. Review Nutrient Management Plans and enter information in Transcendent – 10 landowners
2. Work on design for waste storage structure.
3. Completed design for culvert outlet protection.
4. Completed design grass waterway and diversion plan.
5. Completed design for streambank stabilization project.
6. Work with Matt Ruark – UW Madison, to stakeout some nitrogen study plots.
7. Assist Highway Dept. with some culvert assessments.
8. Complete the design and check the construction for a stormwater basin for the Town of Princeton.
9. Gather survey data and begin designing a grassed waterway outlet for the Town of Princeton.
10. Make design changes to a manure storage structure in the Town of Green Lake per the review of the DATCP area engineer.
11. Conduct soil borings in footprint of the clay borrow area for a waste storage facility to gather soil samples and submit for testing.
12. Site visits to 2 properties that are having issues with water from the neighboring land and give recommendations of how we can fix the problem.
13. Conduct 8 FPP checks in the Town of Mackford.
14. Address notifications in the Transcendent Technologies Farm Inventory Program to bring landowner Certificates of Compliance up to date and mail out new C.O.C.'s as needed.
15. Map well log data for the Town of Dalton.
16. Survey and measure the resource concerns for a streambank restoration in the Town of Green Lake.

July Project Focus

1. Get final review of manure storage design finalized by DATCP area engineer and get sent to Madison office to be reviewed.
2. Complete roof runoff structures and clean-water diversions in the Town of Green Lake.
3. Begin excavation of the borrow area and manure storage area for a manure storage project in the Town of Green Lake.
4. Begin the design of a grade stabilization structure in the Town of Brooklyn.
5. Complete the design for a grassed waterway outlet for the Town of Princeton.
6. Conduct group 4 Farmland Preservation Program field inspections as weather permits.
7. Complete project installations that began last year as weather permits.
