MINUTES

Motion/second (Abendroth/Garro) to approve the minutes of October 1, 2019 with no additions or corrections. Motion carried with no negative vote.

CORRESPONDENCE

• Wisconsin County Mutual Insurance – Deductible Limits

County Clerk Liz Otto informed the committee that she received a letter from our insurance carrier, Wisconsin County Mutual, regarding changes to our property policy next year. Currently we have a \$2,500 deductible and next year the minimum deductible will be \$5,000. Replacement cost coverage will also have a vehicle age restriction – vehicles valued at/or less than \$100,000 and are 5 years old or newer will be considered at replacement cost as will vehicles valued at greater than \$100,000 which are 10 years old or newer. Other vehicles outside of those guidelines will be considered at ACV (Actual Cash Value). The committee asked Clerk Otto to provide a cost comparison when the invoice is received for 2020 versus the one from 2019.

REVIEW DRAFT OF ORDINANCE REGARDING THE USE OF COUNTY FACILITIES

Corporation Counsel Dawn Klockow requested clarification on the ordinance she is drafting regarding the use of county facilities. The committee directed her to include a \$300 deposit to be paid prior to any event and limit requests to within the calendar year.

RESOLUTIONS

• Relating to Inclusion Under the State Income Continuation Insurance Plan

County Clerk Liz Otto and County Administrator Cathy Schmit provided information regarding the proposed ICI (Income Continuation Insurance) Plan which would replace the current coverage in place through Lincoln Financial. Discussion held.

Motion/second (Garro/Trochinski) to approve the resolution and forward to Personnel and County Board for final approval. Motion carried with no negative vote.

UPDATE WORKER'S COMP INSURANCE

County Clerk Liz Otto informed the committee that our Worker's Comp premium is going down for 2020 because the premium is based on claims incurred during the 3 years of 2016, 2017, and 2018. Otto advised that the premium for the following year will be higher again based on 2016 falling off and 2019 being added. There have been more high cost claims this year. Discussion held.

SECURITY SYSTEMS UPDATE

County Administrator Cathy Schmit stated that the contractor for the lobby project is scheduled to be here on November 11, 2019. The electronic portion of the updates is still under consideration with a walkthrough of the facilities scheduled for November 12, 2019.

ORDINANCE NO. -2019

Creating an Ordinance regarding the Use of County Facilities

The County Board of Supervisors of Green Lake County, Green Lake Wisconsin, duly assembled at its regular meeting begun on the 17th day of December 2019, does ordain as follows:

- 1 **WHEREAS,** the County Clerk often receives inquiries from non-profit groups, school
- 2 districts, and other organizations requesting the use of County Buildings or real property
- 3 for non-county functions; and,
- 4 WHEREAS, a policy for applying for use of County buildings or real property is
- 5 necessary to ensure that all groups that request use of County buildings or real property
- 6 are treated equally and follow the same rules for use.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF GREEN LAKE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

9 Section 1. Green Lake County Ordinance, Chapter 121, County Facilities, Use of, is hereby created as follows:

§121-1 Definitions, as used in this ordinance,

- "County-Owned Facilities" means the
- Green Lake County Government Center, located at 571 County Road A, Green Lake, WI.
 - Green Lake County Fairgrounds located at 570 South Street, Green Lake, WI.
 - Green Lake County Highway Department located at 570 South Street, Green Lake,
 WI
 - Green Lake County Highway Department located at N1906 STH 73, Manchester, WI.
 - Green Lake County Maintenance Building, 500 Lake Steel Street, Green Lake, WI

§121-2 Reservation of County Facilities

A. Policy on Reservation. The County-owned facilities are primarily for the exclusive use of the County for the operation of county government. However, under proper circumstances, the use of County-owned facilities or parts thereof may be permitted by outside groups wishing to hold an event. This Ordinance is intended to regulate exclusive use of the County's facilities or parts thereof in the County so that the general welfare of the County is protected.

B. Reservation County-owned Facility Space. A person, group, firm, organization, partnership or corporation may reserve the use of a County-owned facility by written application filed with the County Clerk for a permit for use of the same. The County Clerk shall forward the application to the Property and Insurance Committee for its review. The Property & Insurance Committee shall have the authority to issue permits for the use of County-owned facilities. County-owned facilities are reserved on a first-requested, first-reserved basis, for the current calendar year.

C. Application. Applications shall be submitted to the County Clerk at least 30 days prior to the date on which the use is requested. The application shall contain the following information:

- 1. The name, address and telephone number of the applicant.
- 2. The name, address and telephone number of the headquarters of the same and the responsible and authorized officers of the same.
- 3. The name, address and telephone number of the person who will be the responsible party during the event.
- 4. The County-owned facility being requested for use.

- 5. The date when the use is requested and the hour of the proposed use date.
 - 6. The anticipated number of person to use the facility. If more than 1000 persons are expected to attend, an additional separate permit under Ordinance Chapter 109 is required.

Note: Applicants should be mindful that the Property and Insurance Committee meets monthly and may need to submit an application for use of a facility more than 30 days in advance to ensure that the Committee can review the application at its next scheduled meeting.

D. Fees and charges.

1. Deposit. The applicant must deposit \$300.00. If there is no damage and trash is picked-up and properly disposed, the deposit will be returned. If there is damage or trash left behind, the deposit will be forfeited and applied to the costs. Checks will not be negotiated unless the deposit is forfeited.

2. Applicant is responsible for the pick-up and removal of trash. Applicant is responsible for any damage to the facility. Any damage to the facility during Applicant's event will be deducted from the deposit. If trash is not picked-up and removed, the cost of pick-up and removal will be deducted from the deposit. If the deposit does not cover damage or trash removal or both (if applicable) the County may submit the matter to the Corporation Counsel to recover the damage and costs remaining.

 3. The Maintenance Supervisor shall have the authority to determine damage to the Government Center and Maintenance building and parking lot at the Lake Steel Street location. The Highway Commissioner shall have the authority to determine damage to the Highway Department grounds and County Fairgrounds.

E. Action on application. The Property & Insurance Committee shall act promptly on all applications for permits and shall consider applications at its next regularly scheduled meeting.

F. Reasons for Denial. Applicants may be denied for any of the following reasons:

1. The proposed use would violate federal, state or local ordinances.

If the application is missing any information required.
 The application is made less than the required 30 days

 3. The application is made less than the required 30 days in advance of the requested exclusive use.

 4. If a permit is required for a large assembly and is not granted.

G. Indemnification/Insurance.

 1. The applicant must provide proof of insurance for a minimum of \$250,000 naming the County as an additional insured.

2. If the applicant does not have a minimum insurance policy for \$250,000, the
