PARKS COMMISSION

May 6, 2019

The meeting of the Parks Commission was called to order by Chair Bill Boutwell on Monday, May 6, 2019 at 4:15 PM in the Green Lake County Board Room, Green Lake County Government Center, 571 County Road A, Green Lake, WI. The requirements of the open meeting law were certified as being met. The pledge of allegiance was recited.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion/second (Bernhagen/Morris) to approve the minutes of the 02/04/2019, 03/11/2019 and 04/01/2019 meetings with no additions or corrections. All ayes. Motion carried.

APPEARANCES

Boat washing stations – Anna Cisar and Stephanie Prellwitz

Anna Cisar of Golden Sand Resource & Development Council and Stephanie Prellwitz, Executive Director of the Green Lake Association gave a presentation on their plan to inhibit the invasive species problem in Green Lake. Full scale boat washing stations which would include hot water hoses, etc. is part of the long range plan. In the meantime, they are requesting the following:

- 1) Boat cleaning boards be installed at Dodge Memorial and Sunset Park
- 2) Initial investment total of \$1700 for the two boards and approximately \$90 for annual operation and maintenance to be paid out of the boat launch expense account.
- 3) The county install the signs at no charge.

All cities and towns with public boat landings within the county will be asked to install boards as well. Discussion held. Cisar and Prellwitz will contact the Planning & Zoning Department to find out if there are any requirements and bring it back to the Parks Commission through a resolution for approval.

GREEN LAKE SANITARY DISTRICT REQUEST FOR BOAT LAUNCH FEE WAIVER – COUNTY ROAD K WETLAND RESIDENTS ONLY

Lisa Reas, Green Lake Sanitary District Administrator, requested that boat launch annual pass fees be waived for 6 landowners in the County K marsh due to their inability to access the lake during the spring and early summer carp

spawning period. Reas explained that there is a barrier under the K bridge and in order to reduce the carp numbers in the wetland the gate must be closed so the landowners are unable to access the lake.

Motion/second (Shattuck/Morris) to waive the annual boat launch fee for the 6 landowners specified. All ayes. Motion carried.

2019 PARKS BUDGET

Discussion and explanation of the 2019 Parks budget held.

REVENUES AND EXPENSES

County Clerk Liz Otto explained that the revenues and expenses are reviewed by the Finance Committee on a monthly basis.

RESOLUTIONS

• Relating to Supporting Construction and Maintenance of a Multiple Purpose Bicycle and Pedestrian Trail between Ripon and Green Lake along the State Road 23 Corridor

Jerry Specht spoke as a member of Green Lake Greenways to explain that this resolution is to support funding for the final phase of the multi-use trail. Funding is currently in place for the portion from the Hwy 23/49 intersection to Forest Ridge Road as well as from Sunnyside Road to CTH PP. This resolution would allow for grant request funding for the section from Forest Ridge Road to Sunnyside Road.

Motion/second (Roberts/Morris) to approve the resolution and forward to County Board for final approval. Discussion held. All ayes. Motion carried.

BOAT LAUNCH TERMINAL UPDATE

County Clerk Liz Otto informed the committee that the terminals have been installed and should be working after a technician comes to reconfigure the cell tower issue.

DODGE MEMORIAL PARK BOAT LAUNCH ISSUES

Maintenance Supervisor Scott Weir explained that the launches at Dodge Memorial Park are regulated by the DNR as to depth requirements. No action taken.

MEMORIAL BENCH APPROVAL

Todd Morris stated that the Land Conservation department is asking for approval to donate a bench in memory of Charlie Marks, the former Green Lake Sanitary District Administrator.

Motion/second (Morris/Specht) to approve the donated bench. All ayes. Motion carried.

FIVE YEAR PARKS PLAN

County Clerk Liz Otto distributed the current 5 year Parks and Recreation plan to all committee members. The plan was adopted in 2014 and will need to be updated by the end of the year. Chair Boutwell advised all committee members to review the plan and bring any questions or suggestions to the August meeting.

SCENIC OVERLOOK

Chair Boutwell suggested a scenic overlook sign for the area near CTH B and Hwy 73 due to the view of both Green Lake and Lake Puckaway. Information would need to be gathered as to restrictions, possible grant funding, etc.

PARKS REPORT

• Monthly activities – the report was reviewed and discussed.

COMMITTEE DISCUSSION

Vonn Roberts commented on the beauty of Zobel Park and the high use of the disc golf course.

Chapter 187. Parks and Recreation

Article III. Park Rules and Regulations

§ 187-8. Regulations established.

A.

Park hours for swimming at Margaret Dodge Memorial Park and Spring Lake Park in the Town of Kingston shall be from sunrise to 9:00 p.m. daily from Memorial Day to Labor Day. All swimming is at the individual's own risk.

В.

Any group or organization using park facilities is required to have adult supervision in charge of the group while on park premises.

C.

Park hours in all County-operated parks shall be from sunrise to 9:00 p.m. daily. Requests for variation from these hours shall be made in writing to the County Clerk at least 10 days prior to the intended date of use.

<u>D.</u>

The public is requested at all times to keep all park and other recreational areas clean and sanitary.

E.

No privately owned equipment for recreation facilities shall be stored in park buildings.

F.

No intoxicating beverages, except for beer or ale in metal containers no larger than 16 ounces, is allowed on park or recreational area grounds at any time. Use of larger beer or ale containers will need to be approved in advance by obtaining a permit from the office of the County Clerk.

G.

No profane language is allowed on park or recreational area grounds.

<u>H.</u>

All ice fishing shanties shall be removed from County park property by April 1 of each calendar year. [Added 6-20-2000 by Ord. No. 700-00]

I.

No excessive noise or amplified music is allowed on park or recreational area grounds. Musical instruments and/or bands may not be played without prior approval by the Parks Commission or its designee. [Amended 12-21-2004 by Ord. No. 822-04; 4-17-2018 by Ord. No. 15-2018]

J.

No pets are allowed in Green Lake County parks from Memorial Day to Labor Day. At all other times the pets shall be leashed or under the control by the owner of the pet. Exception is provided for a guide dog, signal dog, or other animal that is individually trained to accompany persons with disabilities and law enforcement K-9 animals.

No carnivals or other money-making enterprises shall be permitted on any park or recreational area grounds except for the sale of merchandise by the concessionaire at Margaret Dodge Memorial Park. Disc golf will be allowed at Zobel Memorial Park, and fund-raising will be allowed to support the disc golf course.

L.

No camping or house trailers or vehicles are allowed on park or recreational area grounds except in designated parking areas. No overnight parking and/or camping is permitted.

M.

Boat loading and unloading operations shall be restricted to those areas developed and designated for the same and should be restricted to 15 minutes or less so that ramps and piers do not become obstructed. Boat trailers shall be parked only in designated areas provided for that purpose.

N.

Overnight camping by organized youth groups, e.g., Boy Scouts, Girls Scouts, Campfire Girls, etc., may be authorized only at Zobel Memorial Park upon written application to the County Clerk's office at least 10 days in advance stating the name of the group, the number of campers, the responsible adults (at least two required to be present at all times) and the date(s) requested.

O.

All persons using County parks and recreational areas are expected to use the rest room facilities provided at each such location for their intended purpose.

P.

No person shall bring in or dump, deposit or leave any bottles, broken glass, ashes, paper, boxes, cans, dirt, rubbish, waste, garbage or refuse or their trash. No refuse or trash shall be placed in any waters in or contiguous to any park or left anywhere on the grounds. All rubbish or waste shall be carried away from the park by the person responsible for its presence and properly disposed of elsewhere.

Q.

No person shall in any manner display or cause to be displayed any sign, placard, picture or other depiction concerning any political candidate or proposal, any commercial display, showing or event, or any religious activity in any Green Lake County park or recreational area.
