Brief Narrative of 2013 Land Information Activities (include relevant web-links):

Green Lake County's land records modernization continues to move forward. The funds from County retained fees has allowed in-house work by the GIS Specialist to continue digital parcel mapping. The latest progress check is about 97% complete.

The WLIP Grant funds were used in 2013 to re-establish Public Land Survey System (PLSS) corners that have been unidentified foe many decades. These PLSS corners provide the foundation for accurate digital parcel mapping.

Grant funds were also used for a project in the Register of Deeds Office for back scanning and indexing of older documents. The outcome of this project is the availability of these documents to the public through the County's website.

Website development and maintenance is an on-going process. Changes to the website data is based on an analysis and consideration of requests made to the Land Information Office.

Education and Training Grant funds continue to be used for a variety of opportunities that benefit Green Lake County's effort to modernize land records and make them available to public and private entities.
