What Is Hazardous Waste?

Hazardous waste items include: agricultural chemicals, lawn and garden products, household cleaners, poisons, oil based paints and paint related products, rechargeable batteries, mercury thermometers, swimming pool chemicals, antifreeze, fluorescent bulbs, waste oil, and/or anything labeled as caustic, poisonous, flammable, toxic etc. These products should not be thrown away with your regular trash or poured down your drain. Instead they should be saved for a Hazardous Waste Clean Sweep collection, where they will be recycled, neutralized, incinerated for waste-to-energy, or otherwise properly disposed of.



EWASTE will be collected from **11am-3pm** (*please note shorter collection time to **3pm vs. 5pm***)

- \$20 Each - CRT / Flat Screen Monitors
- \$20 Each - CRT / Flat Screen TVs 29" and Under
- \$40 Each - CRT / Flat Screen TVs 30" to 49"
- \$60 Each - CRT / Flat Screen TVs 50" and Over
- \$60 Each - Wood Console or Projection TVs [Any Size]
- \$20 Each - Mini Fridges / Small AC Units / Dehumidifiers
- \$25 Each - Stoves / Washers / Dryers / Dishwashers
- \$25 Each - Lawn Mowers (Drained) / Treadmills / Grills
- \$15 Each - Microwaves / Large Copy Machines
- \$10 Each - Hard Drive Removal and Destruction
- \$1 to \$10 per device - Sealed Battery Removal Fee

RESOURCE SOLUTIONS WILL ACCEPT THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WITH NO FEES:

- CPUs - Printers - Speakers - Scanners - Fax Machines - Vacuum Cleaners – Phones - Laptops - Record Players - Tape Players - CD Players - I-pods - VCRs - DVD Players - Beta Tape Players - Electrical Saws - Drills - Calculators - UPS Units - Paper Shredders
- Coffee Machines - Heaters - Game Systems - Sewing Machines - Electronic Toys
- Most electronic devices - unless the device contains batteries sealed within it.



TIRES will be collected from 11am-5pm for a fee.



The following items will NOT be accepted:

- Ammunition and Explosives (dynamite, fireworks)
- Appliances and Freon Gases
- Fire Extinguishers and Smoke Alarms
- High Pressure Cylinders (propane)
- Infectious/Biological Waste (sharps)
- Latex Paint
- Mattresses/Furniture
- Medicines (prescription and over the counter)
- Recyclables, Garbage and Demolition Materials
