**APPROVAL OF 04/21/21 AND 05/19/2021 MINUTES**

**UPDATES TO MEMO OF UNDERSTANDING**

Corporation Counsel Dawn Klockow stated that Amendment #1 was passed but she has no signed copy of it so if one can't be found the document will need to be signed again by all parties. Amendment #2 needs to be reviewed by all parties involved and signed as well. Discussion held. Maintenance responsibilities can be determined on an as needed basis by Maintenance Supervisor Scott Weir. Barry Mashuda stated that the Highway Department will not be responsible for any ongoing maintenance due to the size of their equipment. He said there is a possibility they could mow the trail once per year.

**USE OF ELECTRIC ASSISTED BICYCLES**

Chair Rogers read an email from the City of Madison in regard to electric bikes which stated that they are now legal on all state paths but that municipalities can set their own rules. Discussion held. Rogers has a list of recommendations and will forward them to Corporation Counsel for review.

**DISCUSSION OF FRIENDS OF THE TRAIL GROUP**

Chair Rogers asked Corporation Counsel about the legalities surrounding volunteers forming a "Friends of the Trail" group for maintenance and fundraising. Klockow stated she cannot give legal advice but the information is available on the DNR website.
