RESOLUTION NUMBER -2021

Resolution to exceed the 2022 Budget for the Purchase of Communication Radio Equipment for 911, Dispatch, Law Enforcement and Fire Communications

The County Board of Supervisors of Green Lake County, Green Lake, Wisconsin, duly assembled at its regular meeting on this 21st day of December 2021, does resolve as follows:

- 1 WHEREAS, certain components of the County's radio system for 911, dispatch, police
- 2 and fire communications have reached the end of their useful as of 2020; and,
- 3 WHEREAS, certain components of the County's radio system will no longer be or are
- 4 no longer supported by the manufacturers; and,
- 5 **WHEREAS**, the Sheriff's Office has received a bid from Baycom for replacing the
- 6 current radio system with the prices set until December 31, 2021, and an increase of
- 7 10% after January 1, 2022; and,
- 8 2/3 vote is needed to pass.

- 9 **WHEREAS**, the American Recovery Plan Act (ARPA) allows for the use of federal funds
- 10 for government services; and,
- 11 **WHEREAS**, upgrading the Radio Communication System is a government service that
- 12 appears to meet all the requirements to be reimbursed through ARPA funds for the first
- 13 five years if paid up front.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the 2022 Budget may be exceeded to
- include the purchase of a new Radio Communication System consistent with the
- 16 Baycom bid.
- 17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the payment for the new Radio Communication System
- will utilize ARPA funding.
- 19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that should the US Treasury find that sufficient lost
- revenue does not cover the use of ARPA funding, the county will then engage in short-
- term borrowing in 2023 to repay the use of ARPA funds.
- 22 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that every effort will be made to have the cost of the
- 23 Radio Communication System reimbursed by the American Rescue Plan funding
- 24 available to the County.
