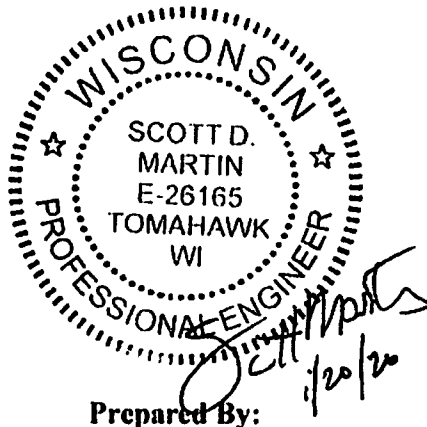



12 be approved by the County Board; and,
