Lake and River Report

<u>Puckaway</u> – Monthly Breakwater design/construction team to review 2022 construction plans are funding sources. Permits have been received for expanded project for 2022. 2nd grant funds have been received. ARPA Funds have been applied for. Installation has been scheduled for June

15th. Approximately 6-8 weeks of construction. Currently water levels are dropping due to lack of rain, and could impede the construction schedule. Construction has been delayed until water levels rise to a level adequate to float the loaded barges.

<u>Twin Lakes</u> – Cattail and Nuisance Plant chemical treatments were submitted to the DNR. Spraying is schedule for early August.

Spring Lake – No updates.

<u>Little Green</u> – The sediment basin on the SW corner of the lake was surveyed. The basin is over 20 years old, and currently past its design life and maintenance period (required). The basin was still in great condition, and functional per the inspection.

Green Lake – No updates.

<u>Grand Lake</u> – Meeting is scheduled for early August with DNR and Lake Association to determine next steps for weed treatments.

WELL TESTING PROGRAM DISCUSSION

Todd Morris and Rachel Prellwitz discussed the results of the Well Testing Grant that was completed in 2020. Follow up testing is recommended in the areas high in Nitrates, targeting families with infants and children. A long-term priority would be to concentrate conservation dollars in these areas for practices that reduce nitrogen loss. The Health Dept. and Land Conservation Dept. will be working together moving forward to educate homeowners on the importance of testing their wells and grant dollars available to assist with the testing.
