SUBMISSION REQUIRMENTS FOR DRIVEWAY PERMITS

Instructions:

1. Obtain a permit from the Green Lake County Highway Department or Green Lake County website for all work proposed within county right- of-way.

- 2. Refer to Code of Green Lake County Chapter 159 & 160. www.ecode360.com/GR2053
- 3. Complete the top portion of permit application and submit with the following information:
 - a. Original copy of the permit
 - b. A drawing showing the location and dimension of both existing and proposed driveway.
 - c. Nonrefundable Permit Fee, as follows: (make check payable to Green Lake County)

a. Driveway access: \$150b. Driveway alteration: \$50c. After-the fact: \$250

- 4. Once permit and payment are received an investigation and field inspection will be completed by Highway personnel.
- 5. Permit will be returned to property owner either, approved, denied, or variance required.
- 6. If **approved**, a culvert pipe and size will be specified.
- 7. If **denied** no access is allowed. Can appeal to the Green Lake County Highway Committee.
- 8. If a **variance** is required, applicant may request approval from the Green Lake County Highway Committee. Variance fee is \$400.
- 9. If approved, a Certificate of Compliance application will be mailed to you along with approved permit. After driveway and/or culvert are installed, complete the Certificate of Compliance application (no fee required) and submit to the Highway Department. If all provisions are met the Certificate of Compliance will be issued and mailed to address on application.
- 10. Nonconforming fee is \$300.
- 11. If driveway needs to be removed by the Highway Department all expenses incurred will be billed to property owner.



Provisions and Restrictions

- Applicant is responsible for installation and maintenance of driveway and/or culverts, including keeping culvert free of debris and other obstructions in order to provide proper drainage along the highway. Any expense incurred by the Green Lake County Highway Department due to lack of proper maintenance will be at the owner's expense. (i.e. thawing of culvert pipe not cleaned, not structurally sound, obstruct by excessive snow pushed into ditch, etc.)
- 2. Culverts shall be corrugated metal pipe, or plastic pipe meeting the DOT standard 530 specs, and conforming to AASHTO requirements. Home-made culverts are not permitted.
- 3. Steel apron end walls with flared ends are required. No concrete end walls or vertical retaining walls of any type or construction are permitted.
- 4. No concrete approaches or aprons shall be permitted within the highway right-of-way.
- All driveways shall be constructed of solid load bearing material. The top surface of the driveway shall consist of at least six inches of gravel upon the traveled portion.
- 6. End slopes shall not be greater than a length to height grade ratio of 3:1. All slopes shall be seeded or covered with sod by the property owner.
- 7. Culverts shall be installed a minimum of 10 feet from property line.
- 8. Return Certificate of Compliance to Green Lake County Highway Department once work has been completed for final inspection.
- 9. Permit shall expire one year after the date of issuance.

530 Corrugated Plastic Pipe Culverts

530.1 Description

(1) This section describes providing corrugated polyethylene and polypropylene culvert pipe.

530.2 Materials

- (1) Furnish culvert pipe, with a corrugated outer wall and a smooth inner liner, fabricated in a plant listed on the <u>APL</u>. Ensure that the culvert pipe conforms to the plans and as follows:
 - For polyethylene conform to AASHTO M294 type S.
 - For polypropylene conform to AASHTO M330 type S.
- (2) If the contract requires apron endwalls, use standard steel apron endwalls, steel endwalls sloped for cross or side drains conforming to <u>521.2</u>, or aluminum apron endwalls conforming to <u>525</u> as the contract specifies. Furnish connector rods, connector bands, or other devices that fit the culvert pipe corrugations and provide a tight connection between the culvert and endwall.

530.3 Construction

(1) Construct as specified in <u>520.3</u> for pipe culverts.

530.4 Measurement

(1) The department will measure the Culvert Pipe items under this section acceptably completed as specified for pipe in <u>520.4</u>.

530.5 Payment

(1) The department will pay for measured quantities at the contract unit price under the following bid items:

- (2) The department will pay for the work under this section as specified in $\underline{520.5}$ as follows:
 - Pipe bid items.
 - Cast-in-place concrete and alternate endwall installations.
 - Water for compaction and dust control.
 - Excavation and foundation backfill at depths greater than 6 inches below the culvert.
- (3) The department pay separately for steel apron endwalls, sloped steel endwalls for cross drains, or sloped steel apron endwalls under the appropriate <u>521</u> bid items; and for aluminum apron endwalls under the appropriate <u>525</u> bid items.
