Visitor Rules

- 1. Masks are optional for anyone entering the facility.
- 2. Only two (2) people are allowed per visit, including children. Exceptions need pre-approval.
- 3. Visits are limited to 30 minutes, 1 visit per day.
- 4. Visitors must provide photo identification upon request.
- 5. Cell phone use is prohibited in visitation area.
- 6. No food or beverages allowed in visitation area.
- 7. Children must be attended to at all times. Children will not be allowed to run freely in the lobby, visitation area or other visitation booths.
- 8. Visitors must be sober. Visits will be denied if a visitor arrives intoxicated.
- 9. Inmates/Visitors must be properly dressed and will not be allowed to inappropriately expose themselves during a visit.
- 10. Inmates/Visitors may not become loud, disorderly or in any way misuse or damage visitation equipment.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE ABOVE OUTLINED RULES MAY RESULT IN IMMEDIATE AND/OR PERMANENT TERMINATION OF VISITATION PRIVILEGES.

Visitaton Policy

Before a visit may be scheduled, inmates must submit a completed *Inmate Visitor List*.

This *Inmate Visitor List* is limited to five (5) adults.

Visitors under the age of eighteen (18) are not required to be on the visitor list to visit; however, <u>must be accompanied by their parent</u> or guardian that is on the list.

The number of weekly visits allowed is determined by the inmate's classification:

Maximum = 1 visit per week

Medium = 2 visits per week

Minimum = 3 visits per week

*No visitation during meal service:

12:30-1:30 pm 5:00-6:30 pm

Holidays:

The Visitation Schedule does not change during holidays. Make sure you call in to schedule visit prior to when Jail Administration office is closed.
