Land Conservation Committee <u>December 8, 2022 Monthly Staff Report</u>

November 2022 Projects

- 1. Inspect open erosion control permits and review new permit applications for erosion control and storm-water management.
- 2. Work on installation of CAPTure P System on basin in Town of Green Lake.
- 3. Complete the design of a rock lined waterway in the Town Green Lake and obtain bids from contractors.
- 4. Continue design work on a grade stabilization structure in the Town of Princeton attempting to fit project into small parcel.
- 5. Meet several landowners to discuss the design plans for BMP's on their respective properties.
- 6. Meet contractors at several BMP sites to discuss installation details and plans.
- 7. Assist landowner and their renter on areas that can and cannot receive drain tile on a parcel of land and work with NRCS and FSA to get verification of work to be done and get proper documentation and applications completed.
- 8. Assist with receiving deer for the Green Lake County deer donation and CWD sampling.
- 9. Assist LCD staff with their project designs and documentation questions.
- 10. Design waterway at a site in the Town of Green Lake.
- 11. Design waterway at a site in the Town of Brooklyn.
- 12. Conduct Farmland Preservation field checks.
- 13. Attend Ag 101 Part 2 at Arlington Ag Research Center.
- 14. Begin design of a Grassed Waterway in the Town of Princeton.
- 15. Continue design of a Vegetative Treatment Area in the Town of Princeton.
- 16. Deliver and calibrate no-till drill to landowners needs.

Lake and River Report

<u>Puckaway</u> – Project is still on hold due to low water levels which impedes the construction schedule. Construction has been delayed until water levels rise to a level adequate to float the loaded barges, likely spring of 2023 since we are entering winter season. District is working with WDNR and private consultants to develop a 2023 aquatic invasive species treatment plan.

<u>Twin Lakes</u> – Submitted revised water quality study report to WDNR for review.

Spring Lake - No updates.

<u>Green Lake</u> – Completed shoreland restoration project at Green Lake Conservancy property.

<u>Grand Lake</u> – Updated Grant Application was submitted to WDNR for 2023 project funding.
