1. WI-CAMS the State ID system that we are using in the County was updated by our IT department. We are now able to make cards for anyone that would be part of our Emergency Operations Center (EOC).
2. I attend a state WEM Grant Closeout meeting on January 24, 2023, which we hosted here in our County Emergency Operation Center (EOC). This involved 14 counties.
3. I completed and submitted EMPG & EPCRA closeout reporting and fiscal items to the state.
4. Completed and submitted the Mitigation Planning Grant application in FEMA-GO.
5. Continue to work with County Fire Departments on ARPA funds that the County Board approved for the updating of their Protective Equipment. There have been 6 fire departments that have ordered or received their equipment, which I approved.
