Workforce Housing Updates | November 2023

I heard from constituents, employers and local officials about the necessity of providing affordable, quality and safe housing so we can grow our communities. I want to provide you with information on our work to address workforce housing concerns. This session, the legislature passed legislation and funding in the biennial budget to streamline regulations and provide funding for workforce housing initiatives. I am including a summary of each individual act below:

- 2023 Wisconsin Act 14: This act creates a revolving loan program operated by the Wisconsin Housing and Economic Development Association (WHEDA) to fund infrastructure like sewers, roads and sidewalks for workforce and senior housing developments.
- **2023 Wisconsin Act 15:** The "Main Street Rehabilitation" act targets funding to revitalize buildings located downtown by offering affordable loans to owners of apartments that have residential and commercial occupants.
- **2023 Wisconsin Act 16:** This act creates new procedures for the courts to review local land use decisions regarding residential development. This ensures certainty and predictability throughout the development approval process for projects that comply with local government regulations.
- **2023 Wisconsin Act 17:** Roughly 60 percent of Wisconsin's single-family housing was built before 1980. This act expands WHEDA's single-family housing rehabilitation loan program to reinvest in older properties.
- **2023 Wisconsin Act 18:** This act establishes a revolving loan program under WHEDA to provide low interest loans to convert or demolish vacant commercial buildings to develop workforce and senior housing. This program requires a focus on rural communities.

The 2023-2025 state budget included a total of \$525 million to implement these newly passed programs. The legislature also increased the limit on notes and bonds that WHEDA issues by \$200 million to finance housing projects supported by state and federal tax credits.

I appreciate everyone who shared their input throughout the process. I believe these initiatives will have a positive impact on communities in the 14^{th} Senate District, and I look forward to continuing our work to supporting the development of workforce housing. Thank you for sharing your views regarding SB 680, relating to the regulation of wakesurfing and wakeboarding. SB 680 was introduced on November 15, 2023 and referred to the Senate Financial Institutions and Sporting Heritage Committee. Below is a link to the official information regarding SB 680:

Over the last few years, I have been contacted by citizens concerned with the lack of regulation for this recreational activity using very powerful motorboats. When Senator Felzkowski and Representative Swearingen sought cosponsors to this legislation, I decided to add my name because the proposal appears to be a reasonable first step in creating a regulatory framework that would balance the concerns of many stakeholders.

It is important to keep in mind that there are folks with vastly differing perspectives on exactly how stringent the regulation in this situation should be across the state. In cosponsoring this proposal, I fully anticipated that it would be amended as it moved through the process. In the end, the only way such a bill will become law is if it has the support of most stakeholders and can obtain the necessary votes in each house of the legislature.

I will keep your thoughts in mind as the bill advances through the legislative process.

ORDINANCE NO. 17-2023

Relating to the Amendment of the Green Lake County Comprehensive Plan. Recommended for Approval on December 7, 2023 by the Land Use Planning & Zoning Committee

The County Board of Supervisors of Green Lake County, Green Lake Wisconsin, duly assembled at its regular meeting begun on the 19th day of December 2023, does ordain as follows:
