Motion/Second (Thom/Lenz) to approve amended ordinance Chapter 257 Vehicles, All-Terrain/Utility-Terrain as presented and send to County Board. No negative votes. Motion carried.

After the motion was made, Ken Bates asked if we could add County Road D to the list of roads on the ordinance that would not allow ATV/UTV's. Discussion was held.

Motion/Second (Bates/Thom) to approve amended ordinance Chapter 257 Vehicles, All-Terrain/Utility-Terrain adding County Road D to the list of roads that do not allow ATV/UTV and send to County Board. No negative votes. Motion carried.
