Feedback from Princeton area residents has been very positive since the addition of the rig in Princeton. Allan Hoffmann stated that response time to the southwest section of the county is still not good and they would like to see an ambulance housed closer to the Kingston/Dalton area. Vandenlangenburg stated that optimal response time in rural areas is 10 minutes. A map will be provided at the next meeting outlining the county coverage and to discuss future placement.
