Morris explained how the change in the Farmland Preservation Program (FPP) in 2010 requiring participants to have a Certificate of Compliance issued by the Land Conservation Department in conjunction with a Nutrient Management Plan resulted in a lot of people voluntarily opting out of the program. At this time, Paul Koehn would like to voluntarily get back into the program and is meeting all the requirements.
