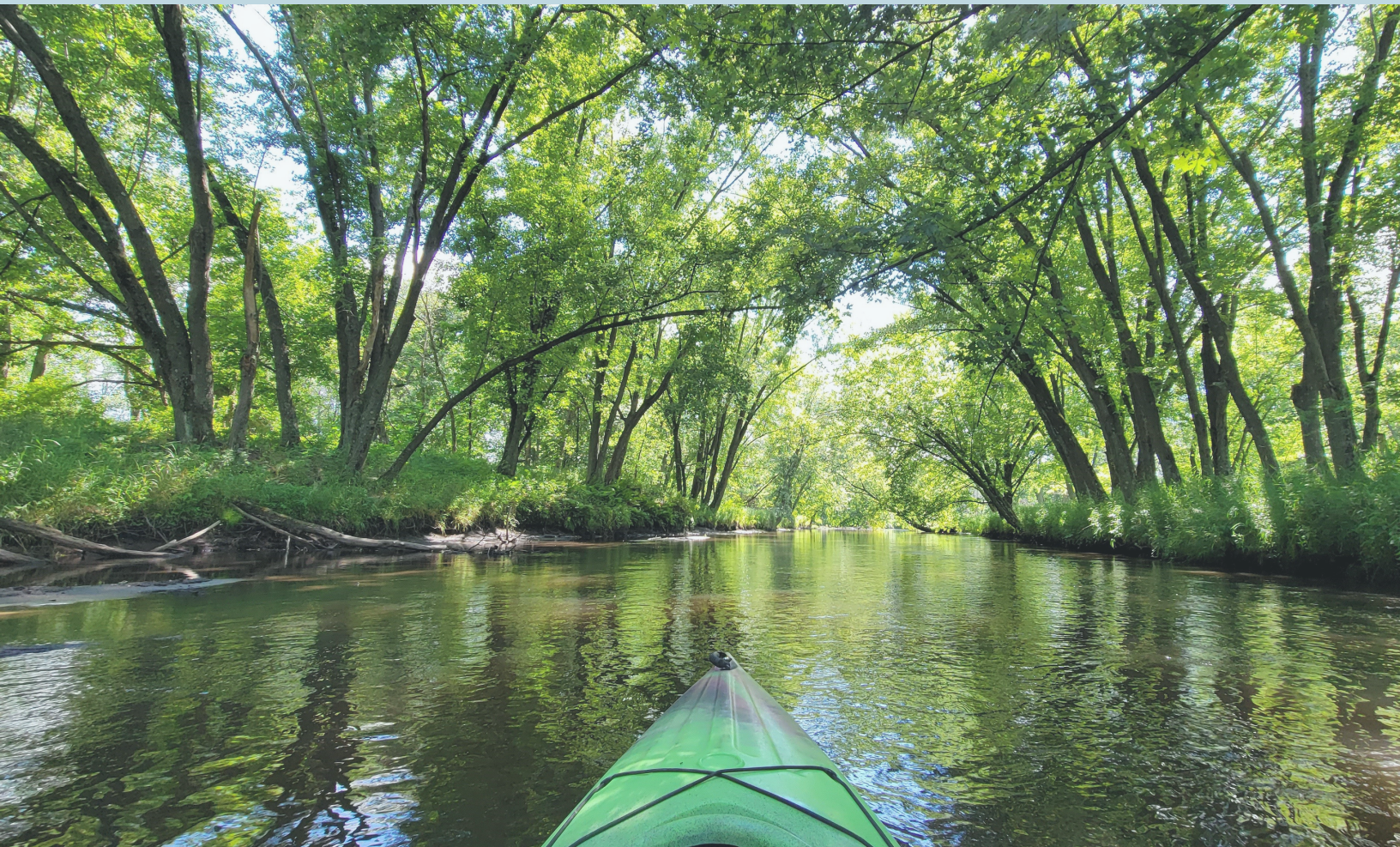

and start exploring!

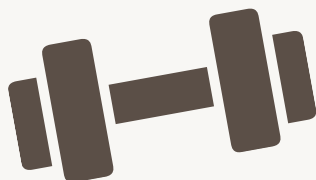

GUIDELINES FOR A HEALTHIER YOU!



Mental Health

- Value yourself - treat yourself with kindness and respect, and avoid self-criticism.
- Surround yourself with good people.
- Learn how to deal with stress - try different coping techniques such as exercise, deep breathing, and meditation.
- Get help when you need it - you can find more information on local resources below.



Nutrition

- Make half of your plate fruits and vegetables every meal.
 - Make half your grains whole grains.
 - Get a wide variety of proteins from a combination of seafood, beans, nuts, eggs, lean meats, and poultry.
 - Avoid sugar-sweetened drinks such as soda, juice, and sweetened teas.
 - Choose water instead!

Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse (AODA)

- Limit alcoholic drinks - The Dietary Guidelines for Americans recommends limiting alcoholic beverages to 1 per day for women and up to 2 drinks per day for men.
- Quit tobacco (Tobacco Quit Line: 1-800-QUIT-NOW; 800-784-8669)
- Ensure safe use of prescription drugs - always deposit unused prescriptions in the designated drop boxes throughout the country.



Physical Activity

- Aim for 30 minutes of physical activity each day.
- Choose an activity that you enjoy doing and can do regularly - this could be walking, jogging, swimming, hiking, biking, or any activity that gets your heart rate up.
- Participate in an exercise class.



Chronic Disease

- If you exercise, eat healthy, avoid tobacco, and drink alcohol only in moderation, you can help fight against chronic disease.
- Early detection of chronic disease is important.
- Be sure to talk to your physician about what screening tests are right for you and to attend your yearly physicals.
