OWNERS/APPLICANTS: Abe Troyer

REQUEST: Variance for Additional Driveway

LOCATION: N1055 CTH H, Dalton, Wi 53926

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: Requesting a Second driveway on property to service the second house.

VARIANCE CRITERIA:

The Highway Committee may, upon appeal, grant a variance from the standards of this chapter if an applicant convincingly demonstrates that:

Literal enforcement of the provisions of this chapter will cause unnecessary hardship;  
The hardship is due to adoption of this chapter and unique property conditions not common to the adjacent lots, parcels or land areas; in such case, this chapter must be amended;  
The variance is not contrary to the public interest;  
The variance is consistent with the purpose of this chapter in 159-3

Variances shall only be granted upon a showing of good and sufficient cause, shall be the minimum relief necessary and shall not cause increased risks to public safety or nuisances.

A variance shall not:

Grant, extend or increase any prohibited use of the lot, parcel or land area.

Be granted for a hardship based solely on an economic gain or loss.

Be granted for a hardship that is self-created.

Damage the rights or property values of other persons in the area.

When an access variance is granted, the Highway Committee shall notify the applicant in writing of its decision. A copy shall also be maintained with the variance record in the parcel file in the Land Use Planning and Zoning Department and Highway Department.

STAFF COMMENTS:

(a) Unnecessary Hardship

A second house was built on the same 100 acre parcel of land and is sharing the same driveway. To get to the new house, people must drive around the back of the first house to access the second house. Owners say in case of emergency there may be access issues getting to the second house.

(b) The hardship is due to the adoption of this chapter for the reason of

- Distance from driveway to STH 44 is exactly 500' (minimum allowed)
- Distance between the 2 driveways would only be 260' (500' is minimum allowed)

- (c) The variance may be contrary to public interest

The traveling public will have to watch both driveways as they approach STH 44 if the second driveway was allowed. There is more potential for crashes with driveways less than 500' apart.

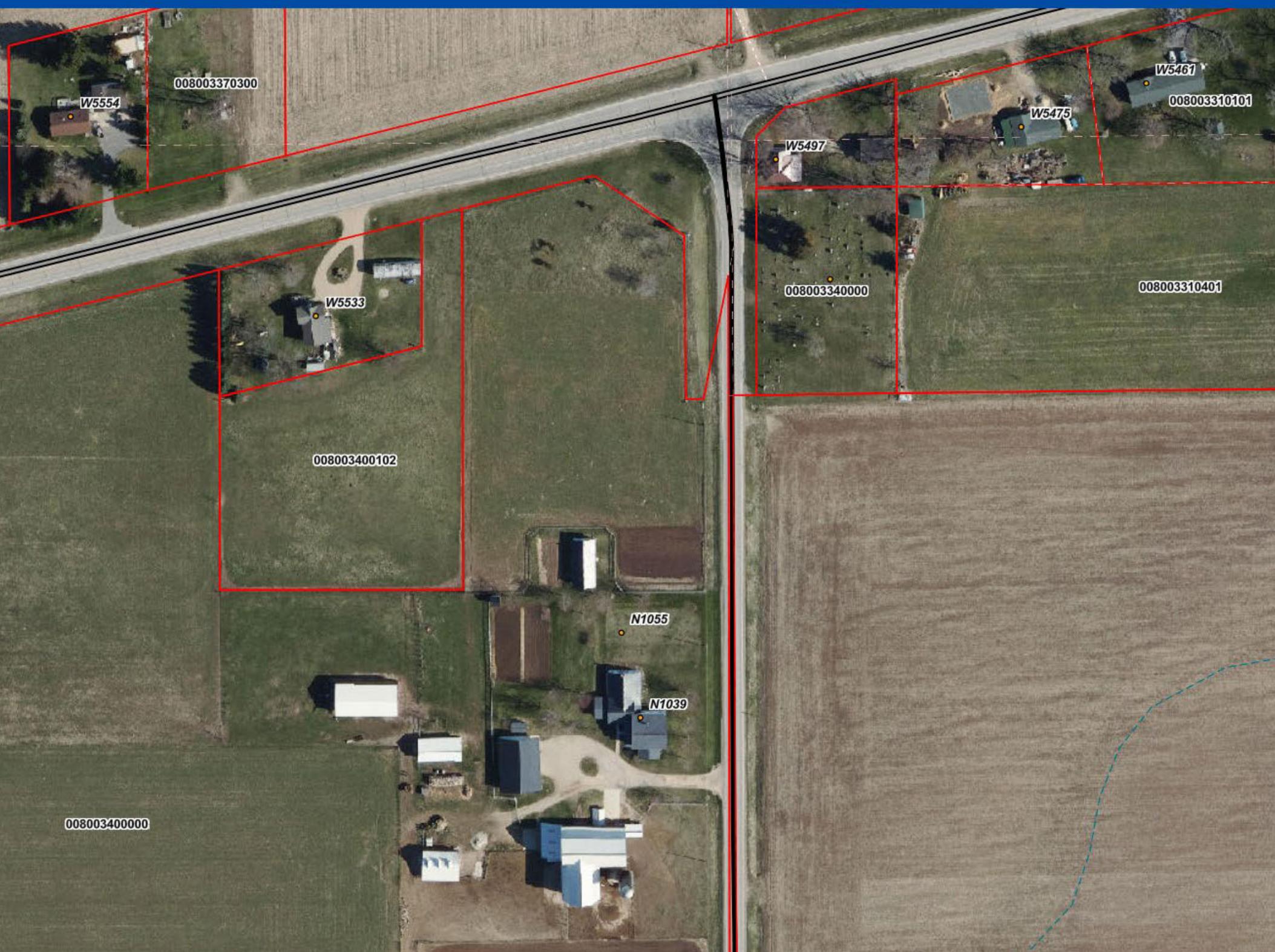
- (d) The variance is not consistent with the purpose of this chapter in 159-3

Granting this variance would allow easier access to the second house, however it does not change the fact that it does not meet the minimum distance between driveways. This will not do any good for the general public or other residents of Green Lake County.

This does not meet current roadway design requirements and will not enhance the appearance of the roadway.

#### VARIANCE CONDITIONS

If granted, property owner must follow all other guidelines and regulation in accordance with chapter 159.

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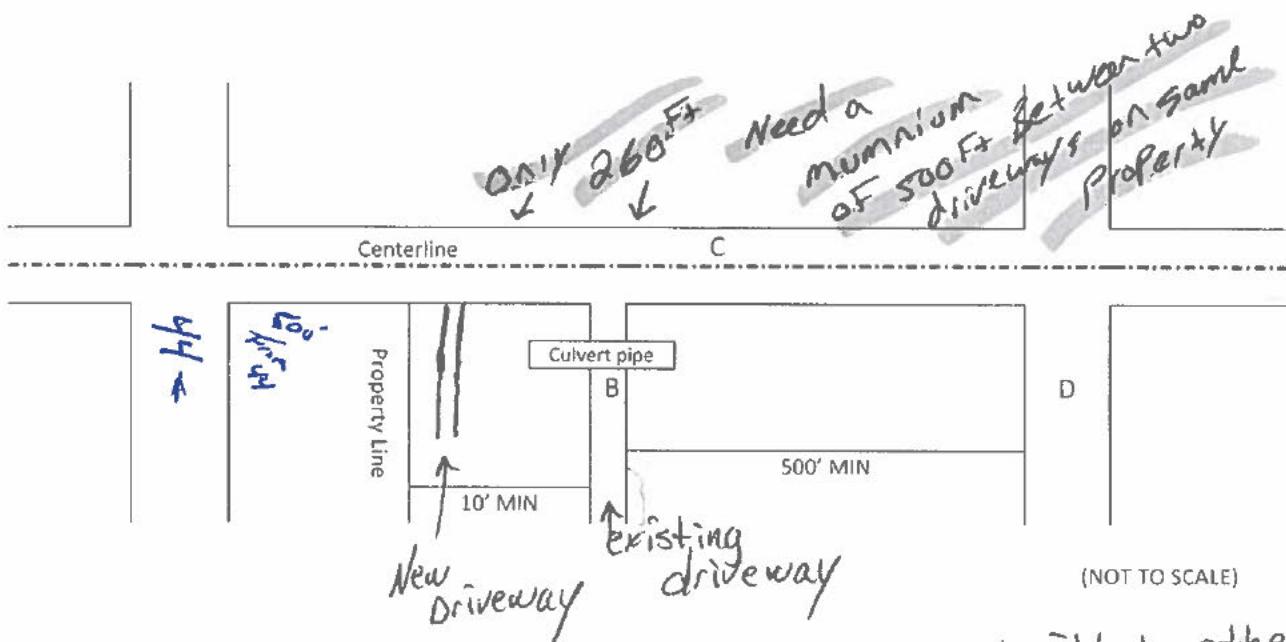

### Provisions and Restrictions

1. Applicant is responsible for installation and maintenance of driveway and/or culverts, including keeping culvert free of debris and other obstructions in order to provide proper drainage along the highway. Any expense incurred by the Green Lake County Highway Department due to lack of proper maintenance will be at the owner's expense. (i.e. thawing of culvert pipe not cleaned, not structurally sound, obstruct by excessive snow pushed into ditch, etc.)
2. Culverts shall be corrugated metal pipe, or plastic pipe meeting the DOT standard 530 specs, and conforming to AASHTO requirements. Home-made culverts are not permitted.
3. Steel apron end walls with flared ends are required. No concrete end walls or vertical retaining walls of any type or construction are permitted.
4. No concrete approaches or aprons shall be permitted within the highway right-of-way.
5. All driveways shall be constructed of solid load bearing material. The top surface of the driveway shall consist of at least six inches of gravel upon the traveled portion.
6. End slopes shall not be greater than a length to height grade ratio of 3:1. All slopes shall be seeded or covered with sod by the property owner.
7. Culverts shall be installed a minimum of 10 feet from property line.
8. Return Certificate of Compliance to Green Lake County Highway Department once work has been completed for final inspection.
9. Permit shall expire one year after the date of issuance.

## EMPLOYEE AGREEMENT

I, (employee name) Bryan Sedarski, agree to comply with the following terms and conditions regarding my use of the County credit card.

## **EMPLOYEE AGREEMENT WITH GREEN LAKE COUNTY TO OBTAIN CLASS A COMMERCIAL DRIVERS LICENSE (CDL)**

A CDL license is a basic requirement for the position of Highway Maintenance Worker with the Highway Department. An allowance is made for non-CDL holders to be hired for the position if the employee obtains a Class A CDL license within 3-months of the employee's start date. Furthermore, the employer may assist the employee in obtaining the license if so desired by the employee. If the employee accepts assistance from the employer to obtain the license, the employee agrees to the following conditions:

- A. The employer will choose a school to send the employee to receive their Entry Level Driver Training (ELDT).
- B. Take and successfully pass the Theory Instruction Training Assessment with a minimum score of 80% to obtain a Commercial Learners Permit (CLP). Provide proof of certification to Department Head.
- C. Participate in Behind-the-Wheel Training to demonstrate proficiency sufficient to pass the state-administered CDL skills test to obtain a Class A CDL with manual and tanker endorsement, and no restrictions. Provide proof of licensure to Department Head.
- D. Remain actively employed with Green Lake County, for a period of thirty-six (36) months.
- E. Should the employee fail to obtain the Class A CDL within the three (3) month period, obtain the class A CDL and voluntarily terminate employment with Green Lake County prior to the end of the thirty-six (36) month period, or obtain the class A CDL and be discharged for cause prior to the end of the thirty-six (36) month period, the employee agrees to repay the employer the direct and indirect costs incurred by the employer for the training. The proportion of costs that must be paid to the employer is based on the following schedule:
  - Less than one year of complete service: 100%
  - Greater than one year, but less than two years: 66%
  - Greater than two years, but less than three years: 33%
  - Greater than three years: 0%
- F. The Employee agrees that the reimbursement amount shall be deducted from their final paycheck, if applicable, or paid in full by the Employee to the Employer via a mutually agreed-upon method of payment.
- G. Repayment should be made as a lump sum or in up to twelve (12) monthly payments starting the month following employee's last day of work. Repayment will be made directly to Green Lake County.
- H. This agreement shall be canceled in its entirety upon completion of thirty-six (36) months of continued employment or in the event of death, a permanent layoff, or a permanent disability prior to the thirty-six (36) month date.

- I. Direct and indirect costs incurred to complete the ELDT course training and to receive the certifications may include, but are not limited to, registration fees for the ELDT course, Theory Instruction Training Assessment, fees for obtaining the CLP, fees for testing and obtaining the CDL, wages and benefits received by the employee from the employer for Theory Instruction study time and Behind-the-Wheel time, equipment rental rates as established by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation of the class of vehicles being used, wages and benefits paid to the Behind-the-Wheel instructor, and any other associated costs. The employer will track all costs incurred during the training in a special account at the Highway Department.
- J. Wages will be paid at a discounted rate while the employee is involved in activities related to the class and training. The rate will be 60% of agreed starting wage. Any study time spent outside of normal work hours will not be compensable.
