DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION ON BERIN EMS AMBULANCE PURCHASE

Evan Vandenlangenburg stated that Berlin EMS needs to replace their 2011 ambulance and there is a 2-3 year window to receive the unit. 3 quotes were included in the packet with Vandenlangenburg stating that all of their current units are Life Line ambulances and he recommends staying with that since it is also the least expensive. Discussion held. *Motion/second (Hoffmann/Gonyo)* to approve the quote of \$365,609 from Life Line for a new ambulance. Ayes – 4, Abstain 1 (Vandenlangenburg), Nays – 0, Absent – 2 (Wielgosh, Wuest). Motion carried.

Joel Strahota provided an update on the new ambulance for Southern Green Lake County Ambulance Service. The unit was ordered 2 years ago and should be here by the end of the year.
