#### **Mental Health**

- Value yourself treat yourself with kindness and respect and avoid self-criticism.
- Surround yourself with good people.
- Learn how to deal with stress try different coping techniques such as exercise, deep breathing, and meditation.
- Get help when you need it you can find more information on local resources below.



# Alcohol and Other Drug Abuse (AODA)

- Limit alcoholic drinks The Dietary Guidelines for Americans recommends limiting alcoholic beverages to 1 per day for women and up to 2 drinks per day for men.
- Quit tobacco. (Tobacco Quit Line: 1-800-QUIT-NOW; 800-784-8669)
- Ensure safe use of prescription drugs - always deposit unused prescriptions in the designated drop boxes throughout the county.



#### **Nutrition**

- Make half of your plate fruits and vegetables every meal.
- Make half your grains whole grains.
- Get a wide variety of proteins from a combination of seafood, beans, nuts, eggs, lean meats, and poultry.
- Avoid sugar-sweetened drinks such as soda, juice, and sweetened teas.
- · Choose water instead!

### **Physical Activity**

- Aim for 30 minutes of physical activity each day.
- Choose an activity that you enjoy doing and can do regularly - this could be walking, jogging, swimming, hiking, biking, or any activity that gets your heart rate up.
- Participate in an exercise class.



#### Chronic Disease

- If you exercise, eat healthy, avoid tobacco, and drink alcohol only in moderation, you can help fight against chronic disease.
- Early detection of chronic disease is important.
- Be sure to talk to your physician about what screening tests are right for you and to attend your yearly physicals.



White River Marsh: A 12,000-acre property in the northwest corner of Green Lake County, 3 miles west of Berlin. Consists of open marsh/wet meadow, swamp hardwoods, tamarack swamp, upland prairie/oak savanna and shrub carr.







Grand River Marsh: A 7,000 acre property in southwest Green lake County/ southeast Marquette County near Lake Puckaway. Consists of open marsh/cattail wetland, upland prairie, oak savannah and shrub carr/wet meadow.

Green Lake Conservancy: A nonprofit land trust protecting special places around Green Lake including Tichora, Mitchell Glen, Norwegian Bay Wetlands and many more. While not all areas are open to the public, many are. For more information go to:




