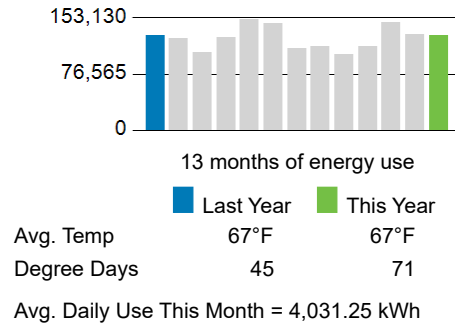

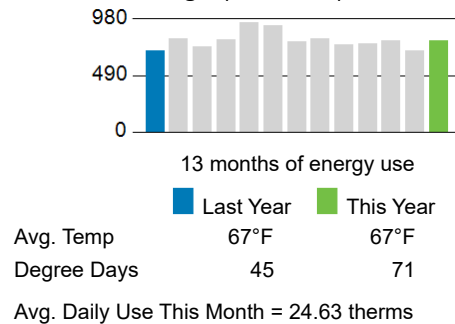

Electric fuel cost adjustments

Guided by our purpose-driven strategy to serve customers and build stronger communities, Alliant Energy continues to take bold, thoughtful actions to deliver value for customers and mitigate long-term cost risks. As we advance the plans outlined in our Energy Blueprint, we continue to invest in a balanced mix of generation resources to support a cost-effective and reliable energy portfolio. Our all-of-the-above approach integrates new, renewable and traditional energy sources to balance innovation with proven solutions and meet customer demand.

The Public Service Commission of Wisconsin (PSC) requires utilities to file an annual forecasted fuel cost plan, which is reviewed by the PSC and used to establish the utility's fuel rates for the following calendar year. The PSC annually reviews actual monitored fuel costs for over- or under-collection and may approve bill credits or adjustments to reconcile differences. In Wisconsin, fuel costs are a pass-through, meaning utilities such as Alliant Energy do not profit.

On Aug. 28, 2025, the PSC completed their review of Alliant Energy's monitored fuel costs and approved a plan to reconcile the under-collection of 2024 costs. In order to reconcile the under-collection, the PSC approved a fuel surcharge adjustment of \$0.002942/kWh over a 3-month period, effective Oct. 1, 2025. On average, residential customer bills will increase by approximately 1.6% and commercial and industrial customer bills will increase by approximately 3.1% per month. This will be reflected on your bill from October to December 2025 and included in the existing "2025 fuel adjustment"; the projected impact is depicted in the chart below.

Customer class	2024 Fuel Reconciliation (\$0.002942/kWh) estimated monthly bill impact
Residential*	\$2.06 or 1.6%
Commercial/industrial**	3.1%

*Assumes customer uses 700 kilowatt-hours per month.

**Assumes large commercial and industrial firm electric customer. It is difficult to identify any large commercial and industrial electric customer as a typical customer because there are many combinations of rate components that impact bills that can vary significantly.
