The regular meeting of the Health and Human Services Combined ADRC Advisory & Commission on Aging Board meeting was called to order by Chair Reabe at 10:30am on Thursday, July 23, 2026, in the County Board Room, Green Lake County Government Center, Green Lake WI. The meeting was held in person and via Teams. The requirements of the open meeting law were certified as being met. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Introductions:

Introductions were completed.

Election of Vice Chair:

Chair Reabe called for nominations for Vice Chair of the Combined ADRC Advisory & Commission on Aging Board Meeting. Reabe nominated Charlie Wielgosh. No other nominations. All Ayes. Vote carried.

Minutes of 5/21/26:

Motion/second (Wielgosh/Jungenberg) to approve the minutes of the May 21, 2026, meeting with no additions or corrections. Motion carried with no negative vote.

Discussion/possible action of the Bids for catering the GLC Elderly Nutrition Program:

Ryan Bamberg reported that three meal bids for years 2027 & 2028 were received. Meal bids in packet were reviewed and discussed. ***Motion/second (Wielgosh/Iserman)*** to approve the bid from Markesan Resident Home to provide catering for the GLC Elderly Nutrition Program for years 2027 & 2028 for the southern part of the Green Lake County. All Ayes. Motion carried with no negative vote.

Motion/second (Wielgosh/Jungenberg) to approve the bid from Triangle Family Restaurant to provide catering for the GLC Elderly Nutrition Program for years 2027 & 2028 for Berlin and other meal routes. All Ayes. Motion carried with no negative vote.

Aging Plan Goals Review:

Ryan Bamberg reported and goals in packet were reviewed.

GLC Senior Transportation Program- Recruited a new driver and currently have three volunteer drivers. Berlin Senior Center is exploring not being a provider for the 85.21 grant. Green Lake County insurance can provide secondary liability coverage for volunteer drivers. Discussion followed.

Minimize Social Isolation- No update.

*Nutrition Program-*Pop-up congregate meal site planned for 8/14/26 at the Green Lake Legion Hall.

Tickets are being sold for \$7.00 (60 yrs+) for a chicken BBQ meal. Meal count totals in packet reviewed.

Create Peer to Peer Volunteer Database- created a liability waiver form and spreadsheet database to track skills of volunteers. Recruited one person who will do grocery shopping & delivery. Discussion followed.

3-year Aging Goals 2025 - 2027

1. Senior Transportation Program
 - a. Recruited 2 new drivers. 1 male and 1 female. Currently have 4 drivers.
 - b. Berlin Senior Center stopped providing rides 08/01. Have not received calls that rides are not being met.
2. Minimize Social Isolation (Senior Friends Volunteer Program) – promote health promotion programs
 - A. Will host a social hour at the Health and Wellness Fair to encourage individuals to interact with each other.
3. Nutrition Program – Highlight on menus most liked meals and create pop-up events
 - a. August 14th event was a success. People enjoyed the meal. Many asked for us to bring it back next year.
 - b. Working closely with new 2027 caterer Family Triangle to put together a menu for 2027.
4. Create a Peer-to-Peer Volunteer Database
