Minimize Social Isolation- Health and Wellness Fair 9/17/26. 44 vendors confirmed. Will have a social hour during the health and wellness fair at Towne Square.

Nutrition Program-ENP pop-up chicken BBQ event at American Legion Hall in Green Lake went well.

Received compliments about event. Will consider having event next year and increase number of dinners. Meeting with new ENP caterer Family Triangle Restaurant to establish a menu for 2027 and work out logistics of packaging meals, etc. Will provide a menu to committee at next meeting. Average donations for meals discussed. Discussion followed.

Create Peer to Peer Volunteer Database- have volunteers who are willing to do grocery shopping and a few high schoolers who will do yard work in the Fall. Discussion followed.

Increase opportunities for Tribal Nations to access services- No update.

ADRC Updates:

Ryan Bamberg reported that ADRC has provided outreach and preventative care resources at 36 events so far this year and interacted with 659 people. ADRC provides referrals to Senior Oasis for individuals who want to tour long-term care facilities. Discussion followed.
