Vandeyacht welcomed Service Commissioner Derek Kohn whom the county board appointed to fill in until the end of Robert Burdicks term.

Vandeyacht reported that the 2026 WDVA/CVSO grant was submitted and received.

New Business: Vandeyacht reported that the 2027 Budget cycle is kicking off and so far hasn't been asked to reduce the budget. It will be submitted to the county manger after the Service Commission looks at it during this meeting.

The CVSO fall conference will be in Waupaca in October. Vandeyacht is the state association of CVSO's tech person. He maintains the website and forums as well as maintains the equipment for the association.

Service Office Report: Vandeyacht reported that this years contacts remain high. Not quite to the level of 2023. This is driven in part by some of the conflicting messages out of Washington and all over the internet. While it is great in that it creates traffic and questions, it is also bad as there is lots of misinformation and fear within the community.

Vandeyacht reported that one of the goals for this years fair continues to find and reach Veterans in the County that haven't been to a CVSO office or to one in the last 3 or 4 years or more.

Financial Report: After discussion, Hudzinski made a motion to approve the Financial Report as submitted. Second by Kohn All ayes. Motion carried.
